DOVE HUNT IN KS AND NE

We have been working with Mark Beam for many years and he has a new operation in Kansas and here is a fun opportunity to take advantage of.

The Dove hunting in Kansas is great in September and here is a chance to hunt in KS and Nebraska the first two weeks of the season.

You will hunt in both states (the KS lodge is only a few miles from the NE line and his property there) Meals, lodging and you can shoot 15 birds per day in each state (so 30 birds per day!!). 3 days of hunting for Doves including all of the aforementioned inclusions for up to 8 hunters for \$475 per person. My wife and I hunted with Mark for Turkey in April and there were a lot of Doves then, but there are thousands of birds now and it will only get better.
