CHICAGO GUN LAW GOES INTO EFFECT....THIS IS A CRIME!

A new gun ordinance in Chicago that officials say is the strictest of its kind in the country went into effect today, the Associated Press reports. The Illinois Association of Firearms Retailers has filed a lawsuit challenging the ordinance. The new regulations were pushed through quickly by Mayor Richard Daley and the City Council after the Supreme Court's decision last month. The ordinance permits residents to have only one working gun at a time in their homes and prohibits them from stepping outside, even onto their porches or in their garages, with a handgun. The ordinance also bans firearms retailers from doing business in the city.
