A few things for you on this Monday morning:

#### **GIANT QUAIL HUNTS**

We still have some GIANT QUAIL hunts left for this season. If you have not done one of these hunts, you are missing out! This hunt is for a group of 4 hunters and is an all day affair. You can use your own dogs or we will guide you on this wing shooting adventure.

You can harvest 100 birds for the group and the cost is still only \$900 for the day. We only hunt the Quail from Sept 15 – Dec 15. We hunt on a large piece of ground called Quail Hill and it is a shell burner for sure. Call Janna and let her know to put you on the list and start looking at some dates for the hunt.

#### **WATERFOWL SEASON IS ON AND THE GEESE ARE COMING!!**

Travis Reininger, owner of Stillwater Outfitters in Denver, is gearing up for another awesome year and is giving RMR folks the smokin' deal he did last year. The normal cost of a hunt with Travis is \$250 per gun, but tell him you are with RMR and he will give you the hunt for \$200 per gun.
